



Move-In Checklist

We're at your service.

Items to bring:

- Bed linens/pillows/blankets (all mattresses are extra-long twin)
- Alarm clock
- Laundry basket/detergent/dryer sheets
- Iron (if you need to wear dressier clothing)
- Hangers for clothing
- Clothing to last until the first trip home (t-shirts, shorts, jeans, sweatshirts, pajamas, light and heavy jackets, socks, bathing suit, belts, hats/caps, etc.)
- Personal toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, dental floss, deodorant, hairbrush/comb, shampoo, conditioner, soap, nail clippers, perfume/cologne, Q-tips, razors, shaving cream, towels, washcloths, etc.)
- Bathrobe/shower shoes
- Utensils, cups, plates, napkins, Tupperware, etc.
- Cookware and small appliances (only if you are residing in apartment-style accommodations)
- Dishwashing detergent
- Umbrella/sunglasses
- Medicine (pain relievers, cold/flu)
- First Aid Kit
- Backpack/classroom supplies (scissors, notebooks, binders, pens, pencils, etc.)
- Envelopes/stamps
- Computer
- Cell phone
- Calculator
- Camera
- Small TV/DVD player
- Surge protector, and/or power strips if you are bringing a lot of technology
- RJ-45 cable (Ethernet cable) for computer/laptop hookup
- Small tool kit/flashlight
- Poster putty for hanging things on walls
- Bicycle and lock (there are numerous places to store on campus)
- Sports equipment
- Names, addresses, phone numbers, and policy numbers of medical, credit card, and/or auto insurance companies

Items not permitted*:

- Rubber or foam backed carpeting (can permanently damage floor!)
- Open flame/coil devices
- Candles/incense
- Hot pots, toaster ovens, sandwich-type grills (permissible only if you are residing in apartment-style accommodations)
- Halogen/lava/torchiere lamps
- Pets (fish are permissible provided they are in a tank smaller than 30 gallons)
- Freezers
